

Prof. Nirmal Singh Emeritus Professor Panjab University Chandigarh



Dr. Nirmal Singh received his BSc (Honors School), MSc (Honors School) and PhD from the Panjab University, Chandigarh. He was Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Professor, Professor and finally Emeritus Professor at Panjab University, Chandigarh. He was Chairman of the Physics Department from 2004-2007 and also Coordinator of the Medical Physics/ Nuclear Medicine Msc Course at the University (2006-09). He received an Emeritus Fellowship by the University Grant Commission, New Delhi and the Emeritus Scientist award by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, Government of India. His major fields of research are experimental nuclear physics and radiation physics and has supervised about two dozen PhD students. He has visited, delivered lectures and worked in many accelerator laboratories in India, USA and Europe. Dr. Singh has been reviewing research papers for many international journals of repute. He is a life member of the Indian Physics Association, Indian Association of Physics Teachers, Panjab Academy of Sciences and Radiation Society of India. He has edited the book *Radioisotopes- Application in Physical Sciences* and *Radioisotopes Applications in Bio-Medical Science* published free online editions by INTECH OPEN ACCESS publishers (www.intechopen.com). Prof. Singh is working on research projects in nuclear structure physics using national accelerator facilities and guiding research in the Department of Physics, Panjab University, Chandigarh.
